

List of Acceptable Documents - TrustID

Identity proofing requires the applicant to provide one government-issued verifiable credential with a photo and one other form of government-issued verifiable credential. IDs are to be presented to the notary performing the in-person confirmation of identity.

All ID information presented for Part 2: In-person Identification Form **must be filled in completely.**

Acceptable government-issued photo IDs

- Valid U.S. passport
- Valid state ID
- U.S. military photo ID
- Valid driver's license
- Federal employee ID card
- Certificate of U.S. citizenship with photo

Acceptable other government-issued IDs

- Original or certificate copy of birth certificate or certificate of birth abroad
- Valid concealed weapons permit
- Social Security card
- State-issued professional license
- Valid student ID from a state university or state college
- State-issued pilot's license
- County or city-issued library card
- TWIC card

Other official forms of ID will be considered on a case-by-case basis provided they meet the above listed requirements.

The forms of ID presented must be free of any apparent defect on their face and must be within their validity periods as of the date that the in-person identification is performed. The photograph must be recognizable as belonging to the applicant.

In the event of a name change, please also present the original, or a notarized copy of the name-change documentation (marriage certificate, divorce decree, court-issued name change documents) and include a copy with the forms packet when submitting for processing.
