

How to Import a Certificate When Using Apple® Mac® OS X

This document explains the process of importing your digital certificate for use in Mac OS X with Mozilla® Firefox and/or Safari.

Mozilla Firefox

To import your digital certificate for use in another browser or on a different device when using Mozilla Firefox, please use these instructions.

1. Click the "Firefox" menu on the top of Firefox. Then click "Preferences".



2. You will have icons on the left side or on the top of the options window. Select **"Privacy & Security"**.

3. The full window will look like this. Scroll down until you locate the **"Certificates"** section. Click on **"View Certificates"**.



4. The **"Certificate Manager"** window will open. Select **"Your Certificates"** and then click the **"Import"** button.

5. Browse to the location of the certificate you wish to import. Select the certificate file and click **"Open"**.

- 1. Locate the backup file of your certificate that was previously saved or exported.
- 2. Double-click the certificate file. The certificate file will be in a .pfx or a .p12 file type.
- 3. The "Keychain Access" will open.
